



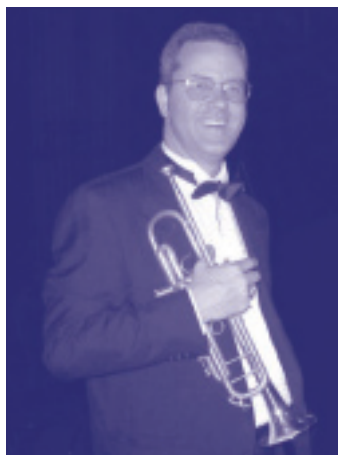
ITG Youth Day • May 20, 2003

ITG Youth Day is being introduced to offer a special day for trumpeters 18 years of age and under. Make plans to see and hear from the world's top trumpet performers and educators as they relate directly to you, the talent of tomorrow.

Allen Vizzutti is a virtuoso classical and jazz trumpet performer. His continued commitment to education and the value of music in everyday life results each year in an extensive schedule of guest appearances around the world. Allen Vizzutti will give a master class and perform an evening concert with the TCU Wind Ensemble and TCU Jazz Ensemble.



The United States Army Brass Quintet has performed for a wide variety of audiences and dignitaries in 39 states and 12 foreign countries since its inception in 1972. The quintet is an element of The U.S. Army Band (Pershing's Own) in Washington, D.C.



Jon Lewis is one of the top recording Studio Artists in the Los Angeles area. He has performed on the 2002 Academy Awards Show and played on many television shows (JAG and Star Trek shows), over 300 motion picture scores (including Men In Black and Men in Black II, Spiderman, The Patriot and Red Dragon to name a few) and plays regularly in area orchestras throughout the LA area.

Chase Sanborn is active in the recording studios and jazz clubs around Toronto. He has written two popular books, "Brass Tactics" and "Jazz Tactics." His master class, "Why is a dominant seventh chord like a cheeseburger?," based on his best-selling book, will make jazz improvisation fun and comprehensible.



Kris Chesky, PhD., Director of Education and Research at the Texas Center for Music & Medicine. Dr. Chesky will discuss health factors associated with trumpet playing such as mouthpiece forces, intraoral pressures, performance anxiety and stress, and sound exposure.

The ITG, in its efforts to encourage young performers, is introducing two new competitions for young players of all soprano brass instruments (trumpet, cornet, flugelhorn, E-flat cornet).

Students are invited to participate in the competitions, which will take place on May 20, 2003 at TCU in Fort Worth, Texas. According to the number entrants, there will be a preliminary round prior to the final: this will all be held on **ITG Youth Day**. Candidates will be provided with written comments from the distinguished panel of judges. Prizes will be awarded in both age categories.

Please note that no tapes are required for these competitions. There is no cost to enter these competitions. All entrants must be ITG members.

Candidates should send the completed application form on this brochure along with a letter of recommendation from their teacher to the Competition Chair; entries must be postmarked no later than March 22, 2003, and received by April 1, 2003.
